- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in August 2018 hiked the repo rate by 25 basis points to 6.50 per cent while maintaining neutral stance on the stability in the market.
- The government in August 2018 approved Public insurer Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) proposal to acquire 51 per cent stake in IDBI Bank.
- The **Startup India Yatra** began on July 30, 2018 in **Raipur**.
- The **Supreme Court** overruled its 21-year-old verdict and held that benefit of any ambiguity in notification related to tax exemptions must be interpreted in favour of the State.
- Reliance Industries (RIL) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with State Bank of India (SBI) to integrate its MyJio platform with the latter's YONO application.
- Launched in 2015 with great fanfare, India's payments banking ecosystem has taken a serious hit as the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has halted two of the three existing payments bank from enrolling new customers.
- NHAI will tomorrow ink a pact with State Bank of India (SBI) for a long-term unsecured loan to the tune of Rs 25,000 crore. This is SBI's highest long-term unsecured loan to any entity and also the largest ever loan sanctioned to NHAI.
- The Union Cabinet approved the **first extension of Concessional Financing Scheme (CFS) to support Indian Entities** bidding for strategically important infrastructure projects abroad.
- The Union Cabinet approved the proposal for restructuring of **Agricultural Scientists 'Recruitment Board (ASRB).**
- CCEA approved issue of fresh 13,87,82,700 equity shares to the extent of 15 percent of paid up equity capital efface value of Rs 5 each by Hindustan Copper Limited (HCL) through the Qualified Institutions Placement (QIP) route, as per SEBI guidelines.
- The Telangana State Information Technology, Electronics and Communication department (ITE&C) in August 2018 signed an MoU with Tech Mahindra to launch India's first Blockchain district.
- The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) on August 3, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the State Bank of India (SBI) for getting Long Term Unsecured Loan of Rs 25000 crore for 10 years with 3 years of moratorium on repayments.
- Meghalaya recently hosted fifth act east business show to strengthen business ties between ASEAN countries northeastern states.
- Silicon Valley technology giant Apple in August 2018 became the first public company in U.S. history to reach a \$1 trillion market value, ahead of rapidly rising Seattle-based Amazon, cementing Apple's long-held place as the world's most valuable company.
- Finance Minister Piyush Goyal, who in August 2018 chaired the 29th Goods and Services Tax (GST) council meeting, announced that a committee has been set up to look after the issues of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).
- Public sector lender IDBI Bank has appointed investment banking outfit RBSA Advisors as financial advisor for evaluating the potential of an investment proposal by the Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC).
- The growing India-Israel relationship took a step further as six Israeli startups with innovative technologies in the fields of healthcare, agriculture and water management interacted with various Indian businesses.

- The world's first-ever thermal battery plant will be unveiled in Andhra Pradesh by the state's Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on August 6, 2018.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will on 21 August launch long-awaited India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) that will have at least one branch in every district and focus on financial services in rural areas, a senior official said. "The Prime Minister has given time on 21 August 21 to launch IPPB.
- The government of the **Telangana**, a southern Indian state, is partnering with a major IT firm **to** establish a district exclusive to blockchain startups in the state's capital city.
- Italy-based company **Benelli**, a global leader in the super bike segment has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **Telangana Government** to set up manufacturing unit in the state in partnership with Adishwar Auto Ride India (AARI), a subsidiary of Mahavir Group.
- The Goods and Services Tax Council on August 4, 2018 formed a **Group of Ministers (GoM) headed by Minister of State for Finance Shiv Pratap Shukla** to address various issues faced by small businesses.
- Startup India has launched the **Startup Academia Alliance programme**, which is a unique mentorship opportunity between academic scholars and startups working in similar domains, to fulfill the Indian Government's mission to promote the spirit of entrepreneurship in the country.
- The Union Ministry of Water Resources, the NABARD and the National Water Development Agency (NWDA) on August 6, 2018 signed a revised Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) for funding of central share of 99 prioritised irrigation projects under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).
 During 2016-17 and 2017-18, a cumulative loan amount of Rs 7863.60 crore has been availed from LTIF for funding these projects.
- The Union Minister for Road Transport & Highways, Nitin Gadkari launched the **Bidder Information**Management System (BIMS) and Bhoomi Rashi and PFMS linkage portals on August 6, 2018.
- The state government of **Telangana** on August 6, 2018 launched the first-of-its-kind life insurance programme '**Rythu Bandhu Life Insurance Bonds'** worth Rs 5 lakh for the farmers in the state.
- The Union Government on August 6, 2018 constituted a four-member Group of Ministers (GoM) headed by the Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Suresh Prabhu to advise Prime Minister Narendra Modi on whether to continue with or withdraw from the 16-member Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) negotiations.
- State Bank of India (SBI) in August 2018 launched the Multi-Option Payment Acceptance Device or MOPAD, a unified payment option that accepts multiple payment methods.
- PayU India in August 2018 announced entering into a strategic partnership with Reliance Money, leading NBFC brands in India, to offer instant app based personal loans, via LazyPay.
- J.P Morgan, a global banking and financial services provider, along with the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ahmedabad's Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship (CIIE) in August 2018 announced a collaboration to set up a Financial Inclusion Lab.
- The Reserve Bank in August 2018 said it has decided to pay a dividend of Rs 50,000 crore to the Union government for the year ending June 30, 2018.
- The NITI Aayog and the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) on August 8, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and entered into a three-year partnership.
- International Monetary Fund (IMF) has said that **India** is a source of growth for the global economy for the next few decades.
- The state government of Maharashtra has announced a special assistance worth Rs 500 crore for the Other Backward Classes (OBC) community in the state.

- The Lok Sabha on August 7, 2018 passed the **Supplementary Demands for Grants for the fiscal year 2018-19**, in which Government had sought additional expenditure of Rs 11,698 crore.
- Axis Bank has become the first bank in the country to introduce Iris Scan Authentication feature for Aadhaar-based transactions through its micro ATM tablets.
- President Ram Nath Kovind in August 2018 inaugurated 'One District One Product' (ODOP) Summit organised by the Uttar Pradesh government to promote traditional industries in every district of the state.
- E-commerce major **Amazon India** in August 2018 signed a MoU with the **Uttar Pradesh government to support MSME entrepreneurs across nine districts** as a part of the state's One District One Product (ODOP) scheme.
- Exim Bank of India has signed a multilateral cooperation agreement with member development banks of BRICS to undertake "collaborative research" in distributed ledger/blockchain technology.
- PayPal, a global technology platform and digital payments leader, has announced its strategic partnership with and HDFC Bank to offer safer, faster and convenient payment experiences for the bank's card holders.
- Digital payments major **Paytm** in August 2018 said it has acquired Bengaluru-based savings management startup, **Balance Technology for an undisclosed amount**.
- The Committee on Fair Market Conduct, headed by former law secretary **T K Viswanathan**, submitted its report to SEBI Chairman Ajay Tyagi on August 8, 2018.
- The state government of Maharashtra has announced a special assistance worth **Rs 500 crore for the Other Backward Classes (OBC) community in the state.**
- NITI Aayog will host an **Investors' Conference** on August 10, 2018 at Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra for the Holistic Development of Islands.
- **Government e-Marketplace (GeM),** the National Public Procurement Portal, turned 2 years old on August 9, 2018.
- Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Suresh Prabhu on August 8, 2018 launched the 'Niryat Mitra' mobile App in New Delhi. The app has been developed by the Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO), the largest exporters' organisation of the country.
- The Lok Sabha on August 9, 2018 referred a bill seeking to ban unregulated deposit schemes to the parliamentary standing committee on the ground that it required thorough deliberations.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced on August 10, 2018 said that 12 modern bio-fuel refineries worth Rs 10,000 crore will be established across the country.
- The International Monetary Fund says India's GDP is poised to grow by 7.3 per cent in the 2018-19 fiscal and 7.5 per cent in 2019-20 on strengthening of investment and robust private consumption.
- The Lok Sabha on August 10, 2018 passed the Arbitration and Conciliation Bill (Amendment) 2018, which provides for time-bound settlement of disputes as well as accountability of the arbitrator.
- NITI Aayog on August 14, 2018 launched 'Pitch to MOVE', a mobility pitch competition that aims to provide budding entrepreneurs of India with a unique opportunity to pitch their business ideas to a distinguished jury.
- The government proposed a new transaction structure for future of greenfield airports to address the challenges regarding airport infrastructure development. This was proposed under Nextgen Airports for Bharat (NABH), Nirman initiative and its guiding principles are affordability, sustainability and predictability.
- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) on August 13, 2018 constituted a working group to update the norms for insurance surveyors.

- The Union Government on August 13, 2018 dismissed **Usha Ananthasubramanian**, former CEO/ MD of Allahabad Bank and scam hit Punjab National Bank (PNB), from service.
- The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) in August 2018 launched **Unified Payments**Interface (UPI) 2.0, which among others allows customers to link their overdraft account to UPI,
 creation of one-time mandates and pre-authorisation of transactions for payment at a later date, and
 checking the invoice sent by merchant prior to making payment.
- Airtel Payments Bank and Bharti AXA Life Insurance in August 2018 announced a pact to offer **Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY)**, leveraging the payments bank's network in rural pockets.
- PhonePe in August 2018 announced entering into a partnership with Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) to facilitate convenient, fast and secure payments through PhonePe on the IRCTC Rail Connect Android app.
- Multi Commodity Exchange of India (MCX) in August 2018 said it has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with India Bullion and Jewellers Association (IBJA) to set up bullion spot exchange.
- A recent study by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has noted that the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) have been adversely hit by the Goods and Services Tax (GST) roll-out and Demonetisation, which had a significant impact on the overall credit of the sector.
- ICICI Lombard has launched India's first Artificial intelligence (AI) based technology to facilitate instant health insurance claims approval.
- One97 Communications, the company that owns Paytm, has announced the launch of its artificial intelligence (AI) cloud computing platform Paytm AI Cloud for developers, start-ups, and enterprises in partnership with global tech giant Alibaba.
- YES Bank has opted for iCubesWire's AI enabled solution, Instatalk, which provides an accurate platform for the customers to interact instantly with the brand and suits their requirements.
- The Parliament's Committee on Estimates, headed by veteran BJP leader Murali Manohar Joshi, looking into the issue of mounting non-performing assets (NPAs), asked former RBI Governor Raghuram Rajan to appear before it and brief it on the matter of NPAs.
- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) on August 16, 2018 directed all the insurance companies to make a provision to cover mental illness also in insurance policies.
- A Draft Notification proposing amendments in Form No. 13, and Rules 28, 28AA, 28AB, 37G and 37H of the Income-tax Rules, 1962 has been uploaded on the website of the Income Tax Department for comments from stakeholders and general public.
- Multi Commodity Exchange of India (MCX) has signed an MoU (memorandum of understanding) with Coimbatore-based Indian Cotton Federation (ICF).
- No ATM will be replenished with cash after 9 PM in cities and 6 PM in rural areas from next year. The announcement was made by the Union Home Ministry through a notification. The Ministry said that the deadline for putting money in the ATMs located in Naxal-hit areas will be 4 PM.
- Indian e-commerce major Flipkart has augmented its capability to roll out voice-based shopping on its platform to compete with rival Amazon's Alexa by acquiring Bengaluru-based artificial intelligence startup Liv.ai.
- Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) along with its knowledge partner and the government Think Tank, NITI Aayog are organizing two-day India Banking Conclave 2018 (IBC) in New Delhi between August 23-24, 2018.
- Providing its customers with an effective option to take care of their financial requirements, Bajaj
 Finance Ltd., the lending arm of Bajaj Finserv, is offering high-value top-up loans of up to Rs. 50

Lakhs on home loan balance transfer. The amount can be used by the customers for any financial requirement, as and when required.

- IT company **Tech Mahindra** in August 2018 said it will acquire Czech Republic-based engineering services firm **Inter-Informatics** for around Rs 80 million through a wholly-owned subsidiary.
- The International Labour Organisation (ILO) on August 20, 2018 released a report titled 'India Wage Report: Wage policies for decent work and inclusive growth'.
- The Indian economy is expected to grow by around 7.5 per cent in 2018 and 2019 as it is largely resilient to external pressures like those from higher oil prices, Moody's Investors Service said in August 2018.
- The World Bank has priced the world's first public bond created and managed using only blockchain in a A\$100 million (\$73.16 million) deal designed to test how the technology might improve decades-old bond sales practices. Commonwealth Bank of Australia, the sole manager of the deal, said in a statement that the two-year bonds had priced to yield 2.251% and would settle 28 August.
- In a big step forward to strengthen the startup ecosystem in Rajasthan, the Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje launched India's largest business incubator the Bhamashah Techno Hub in Jaipur in August 2018 (August 23).
- **Cognizant** has entered into an agreement to acquire Noida-headquartered salesforce consulting firm **SaaSfocus** in its bid to augment its consultancy capabilities in cloud space, apart from expanding its geographical reach in the Asia-Pacific (APAC) region.
- The country's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)** will soon be introducing **'multi-modal' biometric authentication for its mobile applications**. This means that one of the two factors of authentication would be by using either fingerprint or face recognition or by using voice recognition software on the bank's servers.
- With an objective of raising MSME funds through equity, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between National Stock Exchange (NSE) and MSME and textiles department of West Bengal government.
- Container Corporation of India (CONCOR) has inked a pact with KICTPL for providing rail access to container services.
- Maharashtra government has succeeded in efficiently implementing MUDRA scheme, an ambitious scheme of the Centre. Over 80 Lakh persons have got sanctioned loans under the scheme in the last three years.
- The **Punjab cabinet** on August 23, 2018 approved a bill for creation of a price stabilisation fund that will ensure state farmers get minimum support price (MSP). The decision was taken during a cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Amarinder Singh.
- The Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry is developing a National Logistics Portal to ensure
 ease of trading in the International and domestic markets. The portal will link all the stakeholders
 of EXIM, domestic trade and movement and all trade activities on a single platform.
- Punjab National Bank (PNB) in August 2018 said a Department of Financial Services report has rated
 it as number one state-owned bank in terms of digital transactions.
- State-run Rural Electrification Corporation in August 2018 said it has inked a loan agreement with German bank KfW for EUR 200 million facility that would be used to finance clean energy projects in India.
- ICICI Bank, India's private sector bank, has agreed to a multi-year partnership with Manchester
 United, bringing a range of competitive co-branded credit and debit card to the club's 35 million
 Indian followers.

- Anil D Ambani has resigned as the Director of Reliance Naval and Engineering Ltd (RNAVAL), a company official said in August 2018.
- After hosting big ticket 'UP Investors Summit 2018' and dedicated MSME conclave 'One District One Product Summit', the Yogi Adityanath government is gearing up to organise global farmers meet 'Krishi Kumbh' on October 26-28.
- Union Minister for Road Transport, Shipping and Highways, Nitin Gadkari on August 24, 2018 announced that the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) will start the construction of the proposed Mumbai-Delhi Expressway by December 2018.
- As part of rationalisation post-merger of six associate banks with itself, the country's largest lender SBI has changed names and IFSC codes of nearly 1,300 branches across the country.
- Private sector banks, which have recently come under the scanner for corrupt activities, have little
 concern for promoting education and literacy in the country by providing education loans. A large
 part of lending to the education sector in the country has been done by public sector banks. A
 recent RBI report disclosed that the share of Public Sector Banks (PSBs) in lending to the education
 sector is 91.42 per cent.
- India's first flight powered by Biofuel landed at the Indira Gandhi International Airport in New Delhi on August 27, 2018. The test flight had taken off from Dehradun.
- The Union Defence Ministry on August 25, 2018 gave its approval for the acquisition of 111 utility helicopters for Navy at an estimated cost of over Rs 21,000 crore. The Ministry also approved separate procurement proposals worth nearly Rs 25,000 crore.
- YES BANK, India's fourth largest private sector bank has announced its partnership with the Government of Rajasthan to launch Bhamashah Wallet, a simple instant payment digital wallet solution for the state of Rajasthan.
- The government, World Bank and state-owned EESL in August 2018 inked a \$220 million loan agreement and \$80 million guarantee pact to push energy efficiency programme in India.
- The Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Dharmendra Pradhan on August 27, 2018 launched an online portal to enable easy, efficient and transparent booking of common carrier capacity for natural gas transmission services under GAIL's pipelines.
- The Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust, under the Ministry of Shipping, on August 28, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Railways, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh for implementation of the 362 km Indore- Manmad New Railway Line Project.
- Readying its digital payment service for India, **Tez**, for a global roll out, Google in August 2018 renamed the app **as Google Pay** and introduced new features that could soon help its Indian users get instant "pre-approved" loans from some banks.
- Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari on August 28, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Chief Ministers of Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Delhi, and Himachal Pradesh for the construction of the Rs 3966.51 crore Lakhwar Multi-Purpose projects in the Upper Yamuna Basin near Dehradun, Uttarakhand.
- Over 99 percent of the demonetised currency was returned, as per the Annual Report 2017-18 of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). The report was released on August 29, 2018.
- The Union Government and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) on August 30, 2018 signed a USD 375 million loan agreement for 'Madhya Pradesh Irrigation Efficiency Improvement Project'.
- Private sector lender Yes Bank in August 2018 said it has received RBI's approval for continuance of Rana Kapoor as MD and CEO of the bank till further notice from the central bank.

- The Union Government, Rajasthan and the World Bank on August 28, 2018 signed a USD 250 million Development Policy Loan (DPL) to support Rajasthan in improving the performance of its Electricity Distribution Sector under the State's '24x7 Power for All' program.
- The Union Government and World Bank on August 28, 2018 signed a \$220 million loan agreement and an \$80 million guarantee agreement for the India Energy Efficiency Scale-Up programme.
- Maharashtra Cabinet cleared a proposal for financing farmers for purchasing farm equipment with an initial corpus of Rs 50 crore.
- The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) on August 28, 2018 approved projects worth nearly Rs 150 crores to clean Ganga River and its banks in Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and West Bengal under the Namami Gange programme.
- The production of foodgrains touched a record high of 284.8 million tonnes in 2017-18 on the back of last year's normal monsoon, as per the fourth advance estimates of crop production by the Agriculture Ministry, which were released on August 28, 2018.
- The National Mission on Government e Marketplace (GeM) will be launched on September 5, 2018 to accelerate the adoption and use of GeM by major central ministries, state governments and their agencies.
- NITI Aayog Vice Chairman Rajiv Kumar, along with CEO Amitabh Kant, on August 30, 2018 unveiled a series of events to take place during the 'Mobility Week' from August 31 to September 6, 2018.
- India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) on August 30, 2018 signed a USD 346 million loan agreement to finance improvement of over 400 kilometres of state highways under the KSHIP-III Project in Karnataka.
- Indian Railways on August 30, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with GAIL (India)
 Limited to provide infrastructure facilities for supply of Natural Gas to Indian Railways Workshops,
 Production Units and Depots.
- The Shipping Ministry on August 30, 2018 signed a new wage settlement agreement for **Group C & D category of Port and Dock Workers in Mumbai, Maharashtra**. The move will benefit around one lakh 35 thousand port and dock workers and pensioners in 12 major ports across the country.

- India and Germany on August 1, 2018 signed an agreement on financial and technical cooperation, with a special focus on sustainable urban development and renewable energy.
- The Union Ministry of Culture on August 1, 2018 launched a scheme **Seva Bhoj Yojna** to reimburse central share of CGST and IGST on food, prasad, langar or bhandara offered by religious and charitable institutions.
- **Telangana** police is now equipped with another 'powerful' tool 'Facial Recognition System' (FRS) that would help them prevent crime and identify criminals/suspects at lightning speed.
- Rajasthan Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje on August 1, 2018 approved a proposal to set up 55 courts under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act in the state.
- The Shiromani Gurdwara Parbhandhak Committee (SGPC) has decided to install a biogas plant at the community kitchen of the Golden Temple here in an effort to reduce its carbon footprint.
- The Union Cabinet approved raising funds up to Rs 15000 crore as Extra Budgetary Resources (EBR) for Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) (SBM (G)) during the financial year 2018-19 through NABARD.
- The Union Cabinet approved the policy to permit exploration and exploitation of unconventional hydrocarbons such as Shale oil/gas, Coal Bed Methane (CBM) etc.
- CCEA approved the proposal for opening of 13 new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in seven States.
- The Union Cabinet on August 2, 2018 approved a bill provisioning death penalty or life imprisonment to those involved in piracy at sea.
- On 1 August, India's Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), a sub-agency of the Ministry of Power, released the country's first energy efficiency index for Indian states prepared by the body in conjunction with Niti Aayog, India's policy incubator. Kerala and Rajasthan achieved "front-runner" category on the index, along with Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Punjab.
- **China** on July 31, 2018 launched **Gaofen-11**, an optical remote sensing satellite, as part of the country's high-resolution Earth observation project.
- The US Congress on August 1, 2018 passed a defence spending bill capping its security-related aid to Pakistan at 150 Million dollars, significantly below the level of more than one billion US dollars per year.

- Researchers from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and Massachusetts General
 Hospital in the United States have developed a wireless 'in-body GPS' system that can track tumours
 and pinpoint the location of ingestible implants inside the body.
- The state government of **Chhattisgarh has decided to rename the state's new capital city Naya Raipur as Atal Nagar** in the memory of former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. The decision was taken during the state's cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Raman Singh on August 21, 2018.
- The Union Ministry of Earth Sciences has proposed to set up a **Cyclone Warning Centre in Thiruvananthapuram**. The centre is expected to come up by October.
- Online travel firm **MakeMyTrip** in August 2018 said it has signed an agreement with **Indonesian tourism ministry** to promote the Southeast Asian country as a preferred destination in India.
- The Union Government on August 22, 2018 unveiled a draft scheme for extending the affordable air travel programme- **UDAN** to international circuits, with state governments identifying the routes for operation.
- The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare on August 20, 2018 notified new sets of specified health warnings for all tobacco product packs.
- The President of India Ram Nath Kovind will inaugurate the 'International Buddhist Conclave (IBC),
 2018' in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on August 23, 2018. The Minister of State (Independent charge),
 KJ Alphons will preside over the inaugural function.
- The UIDAI has directed the Aadhaar enrolment agencies in Kerala, including banks and post offices, to facilitate retrieval of the 12-digit number and provide free printouts to Aadhaar-holders who have lost their document in the flood-hit state.
- India wins first ever bronze medal in sepak takraw in Asian Games 2018.
- The Day 4 of Asian Games 2018 has taken off for India with shooter Rahi Sarnobat winning the 4th gold in the finals of women's 25m pistol event. With the feat, she has become the first Indian woman to win a gold medal in shooting at the Asian Games.
- The NASA scientists, using data from the Chandrayaan-I spacecraft, on August 21, 2018 confirmed that there are frozen water deposits in the darkest and coolest parts of Moon's Polar Regions.
- For the first time in its 20-year history, an executive **Dheemanth Nagaraj** at the Intel India Design Centre has earned the distinction of being **designated an Intel Fellow.**
- Asian Games gold medalist athlete Hakam Singh passed away on August 14, 2018 at a private hospital in Sangrur, Punjab.
- Senior Congress leader Gurudas Kamat passed away on August 22, 2018 after a brief illness.

- To promote the tribal handicraft and handloom products of the region and to showcase it to the
 world the essence of ethnicity, the northeastern province of Nagaland hosted the first ever 'Aadi
 Mahotsav' under the aegis of the Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India
 (TRIFED).
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated various projects in Junagadh district.
- Justice Dipak Misra, the Chief Justice of India, on August 23, 2018 launched three applications for the benefit of the litigants and lawyers during an event at the Supreme Court of India.
- The Chief Minister of Punjab, Amarinder Singh on August 21, 2018 announced that the state cabinet has approved amendments to the Indian Penal Code (IPC) to make sacrilege of all religious text punishable with life imprisonment.
- The NITI Aayog on August 23, 2018 released the **five Thematic Reports on Sustainable Development in e Indian Himalayan Region (IHR)**, listing the challenges in all the defined 5 thematic areas.
- Young Indian shooter **Shardul Vihan has won India's 17th Asiad medal on Day 5 of Asian Games 2018**. The 15-year-old won silver in the finals of the men's double trap event. Earlier in the day, **Ankita Raina** won bronze in tennis women's singles event, after she lost to 4-6, 7-6 against China's Zhang Shuai in the semifinals.
- Veteran India pacer **Jhulan Goswami** in August 2018 announced her retirement from T20 Internationals with immediate effect.
- President Ram Nath Kovind on August 23, 2018 reassigned the Finance and Corporate Affairs portfolios to Union Minister Arun Jaitley.
- Veteran journalist, author and human rights activist, **Kuldip Nayar** passed away on August 23, 2018.
- Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has announced a new measure that seeks to
 facial recognition mandatory for every authentication that requires Aadhaar. The information was
 shared by UIDAI CEO Ajay Bhushan Pandey on August 24.
- Jharkhand Chief Minister Raghubar Das on August 23, 2018 inaugurated **the five-day International Colour Festival** in which artists would depict the state's image in their canvases.
- Chief Election Commissioner OP Rawat has said that Election Commission is ready for hundred per cent use of Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail machines (VVPAT).
- The Supreme Court on August 24, 2018 turned down the pleas seeking cancellation of elections to over 20,000 uncontested local body seats in West Bengal.
- The University Grants Commission (UGC) issued an advisory on August 21, 2018, directing all the universities and higher education institutions to ban sale of junk food on their campuses.
- The Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) on August 23, 2018 announced that the School of Management and Entrepreneurship will be renamed to 'Atal Bihari Vajpayee School of Management and Entrepreneurship', as a tribute to the late Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.
- India and China on August 23, 2018 decided to work towards a new bilateral Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Defence Exchanges and Cooperation to replace the MoU signed in 2006.
- Prasar Bharati and Mizzima Media of Myanmar signed a Memorandum of Understanding in August 2018. This will boost centuries old ties between India and Myanmar. It will also strengthen India's soft power in its neighbourhood.
- The Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Exercise began in August 2018, bringing Indian and Pakistani militaries to participate for the first time in a joint exercise under the anti-terror setting.

- **Former India opener Lalchand Rajput** has been appointed as the head coach of Zimbabwe's national team. Zimbabwe Cricket made the announcement on their official Twitter handle.
- Veteran Marathi actor **Vijay Chavan**, known for his comic roles, passed away at a hospital in Mumbai on August 24, 2018 after a prolonged illness. He was 63.
- Former President Pranab Mukherjee on August 24, 2018 launched the National Electoral Transformation (NETA) mobile application to rate Members of Parliament (MPs) and Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs).
- The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy in August 2018 said 126 MW wind power capacity, part of country's first inter state transmission system (ISTS) auction, is commissioned in Bhuj.
- A very relentless Japanese side overpowered Spain to lift their first ever Under 20 Women's World Cup, beating Spain 3-1 in France in August 2018.
- Fouaad Mirza became the first Indian to win an Asian Games individual medal in the equestrian event since 1982 besides guiding the country to a second-place finish in the team competition here.
- The Government in August 2018 appointed eminent scientist **Dr. G. Satheesh Reddy** as the Chairman of the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- "Atal Ji Ne Kaha" is Authored and compiled by Brijendra Rehi on the BJP patriarch and former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee launched in August 2018 with a message by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

 Bose passed away after suffering a cardiac arrest at a Birmingham hospital.
- Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, J P Nadda on August 27, 2018 announced that 29 States and Union Territories (UTs) signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the implementation of on Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (AB-PMJAY).
- The Directorate General of Civil Aviation on August 27, 2018 issued the **Civil Aviation Requirements** (CAR) or regulations for civil use of Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) commonly known as drones.

- India's gold account opened on Day 10 of the 18th Asian Games with **Manjit Singh**, who came first in the men's 800m final with a timing of 1.46.15. **Jinson Johnson** followed close behind with a timing of 1.46.35 to finish at the second place. The Indians secured the gold and silver medals.
- European Space Agency (ESA) successfully launched wind-sensing satellite named 'Aeolus' into orbit on board of Vega rocket from French Guyana.
- The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) on August 28, 2018 unveiled the details of the **Gaganyaan mission** for manned space flight before 2022.
- Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare issued advisory to all states and Union Territories to not allow manufacture, sale and advertisement of e-cigarettes and other Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS).
- Union Government and European Union (EU) collaborated for research programme named 'Horizon 2020' to develop Next Generation Influenza Vaccine to protect citizens across the globe.
- Department of Biotechnology (DBT), India's Ministry of Science and Technology, and the International Energy Agency (IEA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) which aims at enhancing innovation for the clean energy transition. The parties signed the agreement in New Delhi.
- Search engine giant Google launched **Project Navlekha** to make online content relevant for more Indian users especially in local languages.
- The Assam government on August 29, 2018 issued a notification declaring the entire state as "a disturbed area" and extended the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act (AFSPA) for six more months in the state.
