- The Reserve Bank announced on October 1, 2018 that it will inject Rs 36000 crore into the system through purchase of government bonds in October to meet the festival season demand for funds.
- Assam Government has become the first Indian state to offer a Wage Compensation Scheme for pregnant women working in the tea gardens of the state. The scheme was launched by Assam Chief Minister Sarbanand Sonowal on October 1, 2018 in Guwahati.
- **Gram Sabhas** across the country have been asked to inform farmers about the benefits of **the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY)** at the beginning of the Rabi Season.
- The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) in October, 2018 granted permission to the government for superseding debt-ridden Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services Limited's (IL&FS) Board.
- The Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) launched a National Level Entrepreneurship Awareness Campaign 'Udyam Abhilasha' in 115 aspirational districts identified by NITI Aayog on October 2, 2018, on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and India signed a USD 100 Million Loan Agreement in New Delhi to continue to expand sewerage and drainage coverage, provide sewage treatment and strengthen capacity of Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) for resilient urban services.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) and India signed a USD 150 million Loan Agreement in New Delhi to establish the first Global Skills Park (GSP) in Madhya Pradesh.
- India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed USD 240 million loan for providing safe and sustainable drinking water to about 1.65 million people in three districts of the state of West Bengal.
- The ICCI Bank CEO and MD, Chanda Kochhar quit her position with immediate effect on October 4, 2018. The announcement came after her plea for early retirement was accepted by the bank.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on October 5, 2018 released its Fourth Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Statement 2018-19. Keep the policy Repo Rate under the Liquidity Adjustment Facility (LAF) unchanged at 6.5 percent. The Reverse Repo Rate under the LAF remains at 6.25 percent. The Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate stand at 6.75 percent.
- India and Russia on October 5, 2018 signed a USD 5.43 billion deal for India to procure the S-400 Triumf missile system from Russia.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has allowed state-owned Oil Marketing Companies (OMC) to borrow long-term working capital from overseas.
- The Reserve Bank of India, alongside the announcement of the bi-monthly monetary policy statement, proposed the introduction of a **Voluntary Retention Route (VRR)** to encourage Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs) willing to undertake long-term investments.
- As part of efforts to cut down gold imports and lower the current account deficit, the government in October, 2018 launched the Sovereign Gold Bond Scheme FY19. The scheme retains the incentives offered in the earlier tranche—of 2.5% interest rate and capital gains tax exemption on redemption.
- Federal Bank In October, 2018 said the Reserve Bank has approved proposal to sell up to 45 per cent stake in NBFC arm Fedfina to private equity firm True North.
- **OYO** South Asia's largest and world's fastest growing hotel chain has inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the **Government of Uttarakhand**.
- HDFC Bank in October, 2018 announced the launch of its 'Accelerator Engagement Programme' (AEP) under the Bank's Centre of Digital Excellence (CODE). In this first-of-its-kind programme, HDFC

Bank will partner with leading start-up accelerators from across the world to gain early access to potential fintech ideas and innovative solutions in the area of artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning (ML), analytics, and robotic process automation etc.

- The Union Government has decided to cover damages done to crops in case of wild animal attacks under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna in select districts on an experimental basis.
- Arunachal Pradesh Government in October, 2018 launched the Chief Minister's **Sashakt Kisan Yojana** and **Chief Minister's Krishi Samuh Yojana in Itanagar.**
- The Union Ministry of Railways on October 5, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Russia's Ministry of Transport for the development of cooperation in transport education.
- A 10-member panel set up by the corporate affairs ministry last week will examine the trends in digital economy, including steep discounts in online retailing and whether the e-tailers are subject to any restrictions in their access to dealerships from manufacturers.
- The Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) on October 4, 2018 signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the **UN Environment for coherent implementation of the environmental dimension of sustainable development**.
- The Reserve Bank In October, 2018 announced it will inject Rs 12,000 crore liquidity into the system through purchase of government bonds on October 11 to meet the festival season demand for funds.
- India's growth rate is predicted to increase to 7.3 per cent in 2018 and 7.4 per cent in 2019, as per the latest World Economic Outlook report released by the International Monetary Fund (IMF) on October 9, 2018. In 2017, India had recorded a growth rate of 6.7 per cent.
- The National Housing Bank (NHB) has decided to increase the Refinance limit to Rs 30000 crore from Rs 24000 crore.
- IndusInd Bank in October, 2018 launched the IndusInd Bank Duo Card which is India's first 2 EMV chip debit cum credit card. This two-in-one Duo Card with two Magnetic Stripes & 2 EMV Chips brings the functionalities of both debit and credit cards to the Indian consumer, on one plastic.
- ICICI Bank Ltd. in October, 2018 announced a multi-year partnership with the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC) and Bhubaneswar Smart City Limited (BSCL) to launch a Common Payment Card System (CPCS) which will help citizens use a single payment option for their multi-purpose city-level usage.
- State Bank of India will increase its portfolio purchase of loans from non-banking finance companies (NBFCs) this year as it looks to provide the much needed liquidity to the funds starved sector, and simultaneously fulfil its priority-sector obligations.
- The 29th Accountants General conference was inaugurated by President Ram Nath Kovind in New Delhi on October 10, 2018. The two-day conference is being organised by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
- The Maharashtra government on October 9,2 018 gave administrative approval of Rs 1,610 crore for the Tarli Irrigation Project in the state's Satara district.
- The World Economic Forum in October, 2018 announced its new Centre for the Fourth Industrial Revolution in India, which would aim to bring together the government and business leaders to pilot emerging technology policies.
- Microsoft India said In October, 2018 it has signed an agreement with Niti Aayog to deploy artificial
 intelligence (AI) technologies to address challenges in agriculture and healthcare, and promote
 adoption of local language computing, among others.

- The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MEITY) on October 10, 2018 released the draft of the National Policy on Electronics 2018, aiming for a turnover of USD 400 billion in domestic electronics manufacturing industry by 2025.
- The Union Government has approved a special package for employment generation in the leather and footwear sector.
- The state government of **Meghalaya** is planning to launch **Blue Revolution: Integrated Development** and **Management of Fisheries.**
- Leading stock exchange **NSE** signed a pact with the **Uttarakhand** government to provide access to capital to MSMEs.
- India's first India-Israel Innovation Centre (IIIC), an entrepreneurial technology hub, was launched in Bengaluru.
- India will soon set up a special UAE desk to facilitate investments and resolve any business issues between the two nations.
- The Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Radha Mohan Singh inaugurated a two-day Agri-startup and Entrepreneurship in New Delhi on October 16, 2018, on the occasion of World Food Day.
- Private sector lender ICICI Bank on October 16, 2018 announced that the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approved the appointment of Sandeep Bakshi as the Managing Director (MD) and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of ICICI Bank for three years.
- India attracted \$22 billion of FDI flows in the first half of 2018, according to a UN report which states that the global foreign direct investment dropped by 41 per cent in the same period due to tax reforms carried out by the Trump administration.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) released operational guidelines to facilitate payments among prepaid instruments (PPI) such as mobile wallets.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) rejected Yes Bank's plea to extend CEO Rana Kapoor's term to at least April 2019 and asked it to ensure that a replacement was in place from February 1 next year, in keeping with what appears to be a firm line on restricting the stints of chief executives. The stock fell 6.9% in October, 2018.
- Indian IT industry's apex body **Nasscom** has entered into a partnership with the **Hiroshima government** for co-creating a Japan-India IT Corridor that could be at the forefront of promoting business-to-business cooperation and talent transfer from India to Japan.
- India and Myanmar signed an important MoU in October, 2018 for the appointment of a private Port
 Operator for the Operation and Maintenance of Sittwe Port, Paletwa Inland Water Terminal and
 associated facilities included in the Kaladan Multi Model Transit Transport Project in implementation
 of India's Act East Policy.
- **1Bridge, Facebook and the Andhra Pradesh State government** will exchange an MoU for a project on empowering young entrepreneurs.
- A Rs 35,000 crore plan has been drawn up for electrification of all railway lines across the country.
- The Union Government has issued a notification stating that sessions courts in **34 states and union** territories, will act as special courts for the trial of offences under the benami transaction law.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi on October 24, 2018 launched the 'Main Nahin Hum' portal and mobile application. The launch was conducted while the PM interacted with IT and electronic manufacturing professionals across India through video-conferencing.
- The first trilateral meeting between India, Afghanistan and Iran of the Coordination Council of the Chabahar agreement took place on October 23, 2018 in Tehran.

- The Government has decided to increase the supply of Onion in Delhi from the buffer stock by two to three times from the current level to tide over any constraint in the interim supply of the commodities in the market.
- According to Government Data, as many as 326 products such as Kancheepuram silk saree,
 Alphonso Mango, Nagpur Orange and Kolhapuri Chappal have been registered as geographical indications (GI) so far.
- The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) on October 23, 2018 notified the **Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Mechanism for Issuing Regulations) Regulations, 2018.**
- YES BANK, India's fourth largest private sector Bank, in partnership with Makarpura GIDC Industrial
 Estate Infrastructure & Charitable Association, announced the launch of its first 'Vyapaar Express' –
 MSME Carnival in Makarpura GIDC at Vadodara in line with the Bank's commitment to creating an

- Dubai Internet City (DIC), the leading technology community in the region, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with The National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM), a non-profit trade association and an apex body of the Indian IT Business Process Management (BPM) industry.
- **IDFC Bank** has proposed to change its name to **'IDFC First Bank Ltd'** as it is in the process of amalgamating non-banking financial company Capital First with itself.
- YES BANK, India's fourth largest private sector bank, launched a co-branded prepaid card for the citizens of Puducherry Smart City in partnership with Puducherry Tourism Development Corporation (PTDC), a Company incorporated under The Companies Act 1956.
- Bank of Baroda (BoB), Dena Bank and Vijaya Bank on October 24, 2018 decided to constitute internal committees to help integrate the functions of the banks before the merger happens.
- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi on October 24, 2018 gave its approval for the creation of a special Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF).
- The Reserve Bank in October, 2018 said it will inject Rs 400 billion into the system in November through a purchase of government securities as it looks to meet festive season demand for funds.
- Maharashtra Industry department in October, 2018 signed an MoU with online retail giant Amazon for making available the products of small and micro entrepreneurs through a separate web portal.
- The Punjab government has signed four MoUs with Israeli institutions to address issues of farmers and depleting groundwater level in the state.

- The new ATM cash withdrawal rules for SBI account holders will come into effect from October 31, 2018. The country's largest bank will reduce the daily cash withdrawal limit for Classic and Maestro debit cards to Rs 20,000 per day, from Rs 40,000.
- The government has approved the construction of **over two lakh additional houses in urban areas under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana.**
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Japan on October 28-29, 2018 to attend the India-Japan Annual Summit with the Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe.
- The foundation stone for India's largest Dry Dock will be laid by Union Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari and Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan at Cochin Shipyard in Kerala on October 30, 2018.

- Asma Jahangir, late Pakistani human rights activist and lawyer was posthumously announced as one of the winners of the UN Human Rights Prize on October 26, 2018.
- The **Vigilance Awareness Week** will be observed across the country from October 29, 2018 to November 4, 2018 to promote probity in public life and achieve a corruption-free society. The theme of the week this year is, **'Eradicate Corruption Build a New India'.**
- Madan Lal Khurana, former Delhi Chief Minister, passed away on October 27, 2018 after a prolonged illness.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi on October 31, 2018 unveiled the bronze statue of India's first deputy prime minister, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel at Kevadia in Gujarat's Narmada district.
- Andhra Pradesh is building a world-class and India's first 'Justice City' within its new capital Amaravati with the vision to provide a state-of-the-art ecosystem built on latest technology for supporting the judicial system in the state.
- The Supreme Court on October 29, 2018 prohibited the plying of 15-year-old petrol and 10-year-old diesel vehicles in the Delhi-NCR (national capital region) in a move to deal with the prevailing "very critical" and "horrible" pollution situation in Delhi-NCR.

- **India** and **Qatar** on October 29, 2018 established a joint commission to review all bilateral matters, as well as regional and global issues of mutual interest.
- The 5th National Summit on Good and Replicable Practices and Innovations in Public Health Care Systems in India began in Kaziranga, Assam on October 30, 2018.
- The sail training ship of Indian Navy, **INS Tarangini** based at Kochi, returned after a seven month long sailing across the world to a grand reception at naval base, Kochi on October 30, 2018.
- The Uttar Pradesh government on October 19, 2018 signed an agreement with its neighbouring state Uttarakhand to strengthen inter-state bus services.
- The Trilokpuri Sanjay Lake to Shiv Vihar section of the Delhi Metro Pink Line was flagged off by Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri and Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on October 31, 2018.
- A night trial of India's indigenously developed nuclear-capable Agni-1 ballistic missile with a strike range of 700 km was successfully conducted on October 30, 2018 from a test range off Odisha coast as part of a user trial by the Army.
- Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on October 31, 2018 flagged off the 'Run for Unity,' an event organised to mark the birth anniversary of freedom fighter and India's first Home Minister, Sardar Vallabhai Patel, in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- Anupam Kher on October 31, 2018 resigned as Chairman of the Film and Television Institute of India (FTII), citing international film and TV assignments.
- In a big boost for Narendra Modi government, **India climbed another 23 points in the World Bank's ease of doing business ranking to 77th place**, becoming the top ranked country in South Asia for the first time and third among the BRICS.
- The Republic of Seychelles on October 29, 2018 launched the world's first Sovereign Blue Bond, a financial instrument designed to support sustainable marine and fisheries projects.
- Germany's Angela Merkel has said she will step down as Chancellor in 2021, following recent election setbacks.
- Justice Naresh Harishchandra Patil was on October 29, 2018 sworn in as the Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court.
- Nobel Prize Winner Malala Yousafzai will be honoured by Harvard University for her work promoting girls' education. Harvard's Kennedy School said Yousafzai will be conferred with the 2018 Gleitsman Award at a ceremony on December 6.
- India observed Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, also known as National Unity Day, on October 31, 2018 to commemorate the 143rd birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the Iron Man of India.
