## **Financial**

- The State Bank of India (SBI) will be investing a total of Rs 80 billion in the Arun III hydropower project of Nepal, which has 900 megawatts (MW) electricity production capacities.
- Tata Communications, a leading digital infrastructure provider, has been selected as the principal partner by the
  Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) to help organisations in India unlock the true benefits of digital
  technologies.
- In order to recover over Rs 7,000 crore of investors money, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) is all set to auction 24 properties of Pancard Clubs and its late chairman and MD Sudhir Moravekar, next month at a reserve price of Rs 2,087 crore.
- SEBI will take action in a phased manner against more than 14,700 entities for non-genuine trades through illiquid stock option segment.
- The SBI has announced the launch of its UK subsidiary, SBI (UK) Limited, with an initial capital commitment of 225 million pounds from its parent entity.
- Fitch Ratings in April, 2018 downgraded the Viability Rating of the Punjab National Bank (PNB) to 'bb-' from 'bb' and maintained the rating on Rating Watch Negative (RWN) following a multi-crore fraud involving diamond trader Nirav Modi.
- Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) has charted a plan to promote micro-enterprises in 115 aspirational districts across the country to contribute to their development.
- India and Bangladesh on April 9, 2018 signed an agreement to set up a 129.5 km oil pipeline aimed at pumping oil from India to Bangladesh with a capacity of 1 million metric tons per annum.
- Department of Defence Production Secretary Ajay Kumar in April, 2018 announced the creation of a dedicated defence and aerospace small and medium enterprises (SME) fund, registered with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), where a minority stake could be taken by investors.
- In line with the efforts to indigenise the defence sector under the 'Make in India' initiative, Larsen & Toubro (L&T), India's multinational engineering conglomerate, and Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL), a leading public sector enterprise in defence electronics and tactical systems, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in April, 2018 to cater to the needs of evolving domestic and export markets for defence products and systems.
- UPS in April, 2018 inaugurated a larger integrated logistics facility in Ahmedabad to support businesses and SMEs (small and medium enterprises) in Gujarat looking to expand trade with the global marketplace.
- Cyient, a provider of engineering design, manufacturing, geo-spatial, networks and operations management services to global industry leaders and Israel-based BlueBird Aero Systems, a leader in design, development, and production of micro, mini, and small tactical Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) announced a joint venture to offer field-proven UAV systems to Indian defence, paramilitary, security, and police forces.
- India and World Expo 2020 signed participants' contract on April 10, 2018 for India's pavilion in the World Expo 2020 which will be held in Dubai.
- An Indian consortium comprising IOCL, BPCL and HPCL on April 11, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Saudi Aramco, the world's largest oil producer. Under the agreement, Saudi Aramco has taken 50 per cent stake in a planned USD 44-billion refinery-cum-petrochemical project in Maharashtra. The move will provide the Saudi Arabian company with an assured customer for additional 30 million tonnes of its crude oil.
- The first meeting of NITI Forum for Northeast outlined five development missions for promoting sectors like horticulture, tourism and food processing. These development projects in the region will be based on the concept of 'HIRA' which stands for Highways, Internet ways, Railways and Airways.
- Approximately 1.5 million rural residents in Madhya Pradesh will directly benefit from improved livelihoods, education and mobility with the USD 140 million loan approved by the Board of Directors of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) in a meeting held recently in Beijing.

- The Reserve Bank in April, 2018 tightened reporting norms for the Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) under which an individual can transfer up to USD 2,50,000 abroad in a year.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed monetary penalty worth Rs. 3 crore on IDBI Bank for not complying with the outlined norms related to reporting of bad loans.
- Swedish home furnishings chain IKEA in April, 2018 said it has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Gujarat government to set up its stores in the state with an expected investment of up to Rs 3,000 crore in the long term.
- India has emerged as the top recipient of foreign direct investment (FDI) from within the Commonwealth and is the second-most lucrative source of investment within the 53-member organisation after the UK, according to a new trade review.
- The union government has set up a 12-member panel to review the enforcement of CSR provisions under the Companies law as well as look at having a centralised scrutiny and prosecution mechanism to deal with violations.
- Yes Bank has announced the launch of first ever 'Yes GST', an OD (over draft) facility for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Through this an MSME can avail OD up to Rs 1 crore, based on their annual turnover, backed by GST returns. Any additional assessment of balance sheet or bank statements will not be required
- The National Highways Authority of India on April 12, 2018 signed an agreement for upgradation of Yagyi Kalewa section of highway in Myanmar to two lanes with earthen shoulder. The first International project of NHAI will be funded by the Union Ministry of External Affairs and will be executed on EPC mode at a cost of Rs 1177 crores.
- Boeing India on Aril 12, 2018 signed MoU with Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL), and Mahindra Defence Systems (MDS) at the Defence Expo 2018 to manufacture Super Hornet fighter aircraft in India.
- Global networking giant Cisco on April 12, 2018 launched the 'Blueprint for Digital Education' to skill students in technologies like Big Data analytics, Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Cyber Security.
- President Ram Nath Kovind and his Zambian counterpart Edgar Chagwa Lungu on April 12, 2018 laid the foundation stone of Lusaka traffic Decongestion Project in Zambia.
- NBCC (India) Ltd., the Navratna Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) under the Ministry of Housing and Urban
  Affairs, in April, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Skill Development Institute (SDI)
  Bhubaneswar, for the construction of the institute.
- As part of the drive to double income of farmers by 2022, the government has raised the authorised capital of Nabard by six times to Rs 30,000 crore to help it increase its lending to the rural economy.
- In a bid to ensure timely grievance redressal for consumers, the National Anti-Profiteering Authority (NAA) launched the "Anti Profiteering" online community in association with a citizen-engagement platform, LocalCircles.

## **Non-financial**

- Tripura Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb launched the state component of Pradhanmantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna
   (PMKVY) in Agartala on April 7, 2018.
- The state government of Goa has decided to launch its own app-based taxi service to few key tourist destinations
  of the state.
- The state government of Maharashtra has announced that cancer patients would be provided with free chemotherapy treatment at district hospitals. The first phase of the plan would start in June 2018.
- Indian men, in April, 2018, replicated the achievement of the women's table tennis team yesterday as they won the gold medal by defeating Nigeria 3-0 in the final at the Commonwealth Games (CWG) in Gold Coast.
- Indian tennis' ageless wonder Leander Paes in April, 2018 became the most successful doubles player in the history of Davis Cup as he combined with Rohan Bopanna to not only grab a record 43rd win but also bring the country back in the tie against China
- Manika Batra inspired India to a historic gold medal with her stunning singles victories, fashioning an unthinkable
   3-1 victory over four-time gold medallists Singapore in the final of the women's team event at the Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast.

- The gold rush continued in weightlifting for India as **Punam Yadav added a fifth to the tally with a top finish in the 69kg category of the 21st Commonwealth Games**.
- Indian shooting ace Jitu Rai claimed the gold medal in the men's 10m air pistol event by creating a new games record while compatriot Om Prakash Mitharval bagged a bronze at the 21st Commonwealth Games in April, 2018.
- China has banned the export to North Korea of some items with potential dual-use in weapons of mass destruction.
- Hungary's right-wing Prime Minister Viktor Orban on April 8, 2018 claimed a landslide victory in the nation's general election.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi on April 10, 2018 launched India's first 12,000 horsepower electric locomotive from Madhepura locomotive factory of Bihar. This all-electric high-speed locomotive was made with the help of French company Alstom under 'Make In India' Project at Madhepura Rail Loco factory of Bihar.
- The Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board (MPTB) has reportedly created a land bank with the aim of giving a major boost to tourism in the state.
- The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) on April 9, 2018 launched 'Project Dhoop', which is an initiative aimed at shifting the school assembly time to noon to ensure maximum absorption of Vitamin D in students through natural sunlight.
- The state government of Haryana has launched water ATM policy to provide clean drinking water at public places to the people of the state.
- The historic event of 8th Theatre Olympics concluded on April 9, 2018 in Mumbai after a glorious run of 51 days across 17 cities of India. Devendra Fadnavis, Maharashtra Chief Minister, was the Chief Guest at the closing ceremony. Nana Patekar were Guests of Honour at the closing ceremony of the event.
- A two-day scientific convention was inaugurated in New Delhi on April 10, 2018, on the occasion of the **World Homeopathy Day**.
- The Day 6 of Commonwealth Games 2018 started with a high for India with Indian ace shooter Heena clinching the gold medal in women's 25m pistol event.
- India's teen shooter Manu Bhaker grabbed the gold medal in the women's 10m air pistol gold medal by shattering the games record at the 21st Commonwealth Games on April 8, 2018. Senior Indian shooter and former world no. 1, Heena Sidhu bagged silver at the event.
- Global software major Wipro's Chief Strategy Officer Rishad Premji has been appointed the new Nasscom Chairman for 2018-19, said the Indian IT industry's apex body in April, 2018.
- M Mahender Reddy, who has so far been in-charge Director-General of Police, was in April, 2018 appointed as full-time DGP of the state.
- British multinational banking and financial services company Standard Chartered Bank announced the appointment of Sachin Gupte as its new Head of Human Resources (HR) in India.
- The Delhi airport jumped from the 22nd rank in 2016 to the 16th rank, as passenger traffic grew by 14.1 per cent to 63.45 million solidifying its status as one of the fastest growing airports in the world for passenger traffic, as per the Airports Council International (ACI).
- The first group of China's **Yaogan-31** remote sensing satellites was launched into space on April 10, 2018.
- Around 1200 year-old Buddhist cliff carvings have been found in Tibet that may offer a glimpse into Buddhist art and local history.
- The Governor of Oregon state, Kate Brown said on April 9, 2018 that she has signed the Net Neutrality bill, which bans Internet operators from offering paid prioritisation services to customers, into law.
- World Homeopathy Day was observed on 10 April 2018.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi on April 10, 2018 addressed the **National Convention of Swachhagrahis at Motihari**, **Bihar**. The meeting was organized as a part of the centenary celebrations of the Champaran Satyagraha.
- The Supreme Court ruled on April 11, 2018 that the Chief Justice of India (CJI) is the 'first among equals' and has the constitutional authority to decide allocation of cases and setting up of benches to hear them.
- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is all set to launch first privately built satellite IRNSS-1L, the backup navigation satellite with a new atomic clock

- The 10th edition of a DefExpo India- 2018, a biennial exhibition of weapons and military hardware, began at Tiruvidanthal, Kancheepuram in Tamil Nadu on April 11, 2018. The tag line of DefExpo this year is "India: The Emerging Defence Manufacturing Hub" to showcase India's capability in export of defence systems and components.
- The **16th International Energy Forum (IEF)** ministerial meeting began in New Delhi, India on April 10, 2018. It would conclude on April 12.
- Inspector General Vijay Chafekar was on April 11, 2018 appointed as the new Flag Officer of Indian Coast Guard (West Region).
- Chandra Shekhar Ghosh was re-appointed as Managing Director and CEO of Bandhan Bank for a period of three years with effect from July 10, 2018.
- Jet Airways in April, 2018 appointed former Civil Aviation Secretary Ashok Chawla as an independent director on its board.
- The Day 7 of Commonwealth Games 2018 started with Indian shooter **Om Prakash Mitharwal bagging the Bronze in the finals of the men's 50m Pistol event**. This was followed by an exemplary performance by Indian shooter Shreyasi Singh, who shot her career-best score to clinch the gold medal in the women's double trap final
- The first international conference on 'Water, Environment and Climate Change: Knowledge Sharing and Partnership' was inaugurated in Kathmandu, Nepal on April 10, 2018.
- Diu has become one of the first states in India to run entirely on solar energy. The island is the tenth least populated district of India with 50 acre of barren land which can be easily used to convert natural resources into energy.
- India and Morocco on April 11, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote cooperation in the field of mining and geology for a period of 5 years.
- India and Timor Leste on April 11, 2018 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in the field of public health to extend affordable healthcare to the people of the Southeast Asian nation.
- The Union Ministry of Human Resource Development on April 11, 2018 constituted a committee under the Chairmanship of Gujarat Education Minister Bhupendrasinh Chudasama to eliminate the fear of maths among the students.
- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on April 12, 2018 launched the navigation satellite IRNSS-11.
- Ace Indian shuttler Kidambi Srikanth became World number 1 in men's singles category after Badminton World
   Federation updated its weekly rankings on April 12, 2018.
- The Maharashtra state government on April 11, 2018 announced cash prizes for all the players from the state who have bagged medals in the ongoing Commonwealth Games Gold Coast.
- Indian wrestling legend Sushil Kumar, who won the Commonwealth Championships last December, displayed his top form as he took on South Africa's Botha Johannes in the men's freestyle 74 kg finals.
- **Babita Kumari**, who entered the gold medal round of women's 53kg freestyle wrestling on a high note, had to settle for silver after she lost to Canada's Diana Weicker.
- Indian shooter Tejaswini Sawant grabbed the silver medal in the women's 50m Rifle Prone final on April 11.
- India's skating champion Priyam Tated has won Gold medal in the Basic Novice B Category (13-15 years) in Cambodia Open National Figure Skating Championship which was held in Phnom Pench from 4 to 7 April 2018.
- Former bureaucrat Bhanu Pratap Sharma has been appointed chairman of the Banks' Board Bureau. He succeeded Vinod Rai.
- India was ranked at 130th spot in the latest annual Index of Economic Freedom, which was released by a top American think-tank the Heritage Foundation. Hong Kong topped the list.
- The Cabinet of United Arab Emirates (UAE) has approved the issuance of law on Equal Wages and Salaries for men and women.
- New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern on April 12, 2018 announced a ban on all new offshore oil exploration, as a transition towards a zero-carbon economy.
- The World Bank has approved \$55 million to expand the use of clean renewable energy in rural areas of Bangladesh where grid electricity cannot reach easily.

- Consumer goods major Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL) announced that its Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Managing Director (MD), Sanjiv Mehra, will take over as the Chairman and MD of the company.
- A new United Nations trust fund on road safety launched Thursday, in a bid to address the growing number of road traffic injuries and deaths in developing countries.
- **Veena Sahajwalla**, an Indian-origin scientist in Australia, **launched the world's first microfactory** that can transform electronic waste items such as smartphones and laptops into valuable materials for re-use.
- National Awards 2018 announced. Sridevi won the best actress award and Riddhi Sen won the best actor award.
   Vinod Khanna was conferred with Dadasaheb Phalke Award.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi in April, 2018 inaugurated the first Health and Wellness Centre in Chhattisgarh's restive Bijapur district to mark the launch of first phase of national Ayushman Bharat Yojana.
- The second edition of India Mobile Congress (IMC) is scheduled to be held from October 25-27, 2018 in New Delhi. The decision was taken after the successful debut of the first edition in 2017.
- The United States along with Britain and France launched a combined military operation against Syria on April 14, 2018. The military operation is in response to an alleged chemical attack in Douma, a Syrian town near Damascus.
