RBI reduces repo rate by 25 basis points to 5.75 %

- The Reserve bank of India in its bi-monthly monetary policy review today reduced the reporate by 25 basis points to 5.75 per cent from 6.0 per cent with immediate effect.
- Repo Rate 5.75%
- Reverse Repo Rate 5.50%
- Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) 6%
- Bank Rate 6%
- CRR-4%
- SLR -19%
- RBI lowered the economic Growth forecast for the current fiscal to 7%
- The next meeting of the MPC is scheduled during August 5-7.
