Gujarat launched India's first emissions trading scheme to curb air pollution

Delhi Metro becomes India's first project to receive power from waste-to-energy

- The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has become the first ever project in the country to receive power generated from a waste-to-energy plant.
