- Telangana celebrated its 5th State Formation Day.
- Telangana State was formed on 2nd June 2014 after the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh and became the 29th State of the Country.
- Chief Minister Chandrasekhar Rao hoisted the National Flag at a ceremonial programme held on the lawns of Jubilee Hall at Public Gardens in Hyderabad.
- CM requested the people to strengthen the Government as they are are going to implement three new legislations (New Revenue Act, Muncipal Act, Panchayat Raj Act)

National Sample Survey Organization reveals India has 20.6 health workers per 10,000 people

- A study based on National Sample Survey Organization reveals that India has 20.6 health workers per 10,000 people which it is less than the World health Organisation's minimum threshold of 22.8.
- The distribution of health workers is uneven between urban and rural areas. Rural areas with nearly 71% of India's population have only 36% of health workers.
- Private and Public health sector too have uneven distribution of health workers as more than 80% of doctors and 70% of nurses and midwives are employed in the private sector.
