Rajasthan Govt increases financial aid given to girls under 'Aapki Beti Scheme'

- The Rajasthan govt increased the financial assistance given to girls under 'Aapki Beti' Scheme as well as the ex-gratia payment given to the families of polling personnel who die during election duty.
- The amount has been increased from Rs 1100 to Rs 2100 for girls studying in class 1-8 & from Rs 1500 to Rs 2500 for the girls in class 9-12.
- ex-gratia payment to the next of kin of an official killed on election duty has been increased from Rs 15 lakh to Rs 10 Lakh.

Telangana Govt enhances Rythu Bandhu Scheme Assistance

- The main objective of this scheme is to to give financial assistance to the farmers to purchase seeds, fertilizers, pesticides and towards labour and other field works.
- The detailed guidelines were issued by the Principle Secatary of Agriculture Dept of the state, C Paratha Sarthi.
- Money under this scheme will be paid through e-Kuber (RBI Payment Platform)
